A balanced and elegant wine with aromas of apple, white flowers, honey and lemon, combining the gentle sweetness of acacia barrels with lively freshness and a clean finish, ideal to accompany the richness of this dish.

For a creamy texture and refreshing acidity, with a complex bouquet of citrus, butter and white flowers, perfectly suited to enhance the velvety texture of the scallops.

A finesse and roundness that will enhance the Jerusalem artichoke, fully revealing its aromas of butter, chalk and white flowers while respecting the delicacy of the dish.

Its firm tannins become supple when paired with the noble fat of the meat, and its fine aromatic intensity of ripe black cherry, sweet spices and grilled notes highlights the flavours of this particularly intense-tasting dish.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 2017, Château de Beaucastel, AOC Châteauneuf-du-Pape 45.-

Exceptional complexity and aromatic richness, with notes of ripe red fruit, leather, spices and garrigue. The fine tannins pair perfectly with the meat in this dish.



Oriental-style lamb croquettes, raita sauce



Petit Figeac, 2nd vin du Château Figeac, 2021, AOC Saint-Émilion 30.-

Its elegance and length on the palate balance the power of the lamb, creating harmony between the intensity of ripe plum flavours and a subtle smoky touch that brings finesse.

Pinot Noir "Grain Pinot", 2023, Marie-Thérèse Chappaz, AOC Valais 20.-

Notes of freshly picked red berries (redcurrant, strawberry and raspberry) and barrel ageing that brings delicacy and refinement rather than pronounced oak, with subtle toasted notes blended with clove aromas. A wine with very fine, well-integrated tannins and a beautifully precise acidity. Ideal to accompany morels and their subtle forest floor.

A classic with notes of lime, green apple and a salty finish. On the palate, there is a chalky quality and high, chiselled acidity.

An extremely complex wine with intense notes of ripe citrus and candied lemon, complemented by delicate hints of butter and white flowers

A refined wine revealing aromas of ripe fruit and white flowers, with a full-bodied palate and a hint of vanilla on the finish.

An elegant wine with aromas of white-fleshed fruits and white flowers, supported by a full-bodied, mineral palate with a long, subtly toasty finish.

55% Cabernet sauvignon, 39% Merlot, 6% Petit Verdot

Aromas of ripe black fruit, cedar and light spicy notes. The palate is full-bodied and structured, supported by fine tannins and a long, elegant finish.

This wine reveals a rich bouquet of red fruits and delicate spices. On the palate, it combines finesse and structure, supported by elegant tannins and a lovely freshness.

100% Pinot Noir

A Pinot Noir with character, firm tannins and concentrated notes of fresh red berries. All punctuated by subtle hints of sweet spices.

This vintage has a complex nose of strawberries, ripe redcurrants and black cherries, with hints of undergrowth, spices and wood. On the palate, it is elegant and structured, supported by fine, velvety tannins. Its balance and long finish reflect great ageing potential.

“Les Feusselottes”, Pousse d'Or, 2019, AOC Chambolle-Musigny Premier Cru 355.-
100% Pinot Noir

A captivating bouquet blending redcurrants, raspberries and cherries, enhanced by floral and spicy notes. On the palate, it seduces with its finesse, delicate tannins and marked acidity.

Pommard, 2022, Pierrick Bouley, AOC Pommard 210.-
100% Pinot Noir

An expressive nose of red and black fruits, enhanced by subtle spicy notes. The palate is structured and elegant, supported by present yet refined tannins, with a clean and harmonious finish.

100% Pinot Noir

Delicate aromas of cherry, raspberry, and sweet spices. Silky and precise on the palate, with a long, refined finish.

Blind, one might think of a great Chianti, blending notes of garrigue, wild herbs, amarena cherries and a slight smokiness from its barrel ageing. The tannins, like grains of sand, add texture and awaken the palate. The vibrant acidity brings freshness while prolonging the long finish.

An intense nose of ripe blackcurrant, leather, and graphite. On the palate, the tannins are rich and structured. The 24 months in French oak barrels add notes of roasted coffee and vanilla. A powerful wine, boasting great volume and body.

Intense aromas of black cherry, dried fruits, cocoa, and spices, with a hint of balsamic notes. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied, silky, and perfectly balanced, carried through to a very long finish.

Complex aromas of black fruits, tobacco, leather, and noble spices. On the palate, it shows great finesse, with an almost endless finish.

A very complex wine with notes of red and black fruits, from morello cherry to blackberry, and elegant hints of coffee and cocoa. The tannins are supple and well-integrated, yet they bring structure and intensity to this wine.
