Exceptional complexity and aromatic richness, with notes of ripe red fruit, leather, spices and garrigue. The fine tannins pair perfectly with the meat in this dish.

Petit Figeac, 2nd vin du Château Figeac, 2019, AOC Saint-Émilion 30.-

Its elegance and length on the palate balance the power of the duck, creating harmony between the strength of the plum and blackberry and a hint of smoke that adds finesse.

Pinot Noir "Grain Pinot", 2023, Marie-Thérèse Chappaz, AOC Valais 20.-

Its notes of freshly picked wild berries (redcurrant, strawberry and raspberry) and barrel ageing that brings delicacy and refinement rather than woodiness, with subtle toasted notes mingled with cloves. A wine with very fine, integrated tannins and a beautifully chiselled acidity.

A wine combining notes of ripe peaches, honey, acacia flowers, a hint of tropical fruits such as ripe pineapple and mango, and subtle notes of bourbon vanilla, sweet spices, biscuits and a hint of brioche.

A classic with notes of lime, green apple and a salty finish. On the palate, there is a chalky quality and high, chiselled acidity.

An extremely complex wine with intense notes of butter, vanilla and candied lemon zest.

A refined wine revealing aromas of ripe fruit and white flowers, with a full-bodied palate and a hint of vanilla on the finish.

Corton-Charlemagne, Grand Cru, 2015, Dubreuil Fontaine, Bourgogne Grand Cru 290.-
100% Chardonnay

This vintage offers an intense bouquet with aromas of ripe pears and baked apples, with hints of butter and toasted vanilla. On the palate, it reveals flavours of peach, honey and hazelnut.

Aromas of ripe black fruit, cedar and light spicy notes. The palate is full-bodied and structured, supported by fine tannins and a long, elegant finish.

This wine reveals a rich bouquet of red fruits and delicate spices. On the palate, it combines finesse and structure, supported by elegant tannins and a lovely freshness.

100% Pinot Noir

This vintage has a complex nose of strawberries, ripe redcurrants and black cherries, with hints of undergrowth, spices and wood. On the palate, it is elegant and structured, supported by fine, velvety tannins. Its balance and long finish reflect great ageing potential.

"Les Feusselottes", Pousse d'Or, 2017, AOC Chambolle-Musigny Premier Cru 355.-

100% Pinot Noir

A captivating bouquet blending redcurrants, raspberries and cherries, enhanced by floral and spicy notes. On the palate, it seduces with its finesse, delicate tannins and marked acidity.

An expressive nose of red and black fruits, enhanced by subtle spicy notes. The palate is structured and elegant, supported by present yet refined tannins, with a clean and harmonious finish.

Côte-Rôtie, 2023, Domaine Pierre Gaillard, AOC Côte-Rôtie 100% Syrah <i>This wine reveals a complex bouquet combining ripe red fruits, delicate spices and smoky notes. On the palate, it combines power and elegance, supported by silky tannins and a long mineral finish.</i>	144.-

Les Creisses, 2022, Domaine des Creisses, IGP VdP d'Hérault 30% Syrah, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Grenache, 5% Carignan, 5% Mourvèdre, 5% Marselan <i>A generous black fruit flavour, enhanced with spices and a hint of garrigue, with a full-bodied, flavourful and perfectly balanced palate.</i>	94.-
Trevallon, 2022, Domaine de Trévallon, IGP Alpilles 55% cabernet sauvignon, 45% syrah <i>This wine expresses ripe, pure fruit, mingled with notes of garrigue and spices, with a structured, fresh palate.</i>	267.-

Blind, one might think of a great Chianti, blending notes of garrigue, wild herbs, amarena cherries and a slight smokiness from its barrel ageing. The tannins, like grains of sand, add texture and awaken the palate. The vibrant acidity brings freshness while prolonging the long finish.

A complex bouquet of blackberries, black cherries, blackcurrants, cigar box, as well as vanilla and woody notes. The palate is elegant and structured, thanks to intense, velvety tannins.

85% Cabernet Sauvignon & 15% Cabernet Franc

An intense nose of ripe blackcurrant, leather and graphite. Rich, structured tannins on the palate. Twenty-four months in French oak barrels add notes of roasted coffee and vanilla. A powerful wine with great volume and body.
